

Covid-19 measures

- Familiarize yourself with the current corona rules, which apply to campsites in Belgium.
- Keep 5 feet away from other guests, employees and everyone else outside of your social bubble.
- Each type of accommodation respects the measures established in terms of the size of the allowed social bubble (1 household and only 1 extra person).
- Wash your hands before and after every toilet visit and also on arrival at your accommodation.
- Always wear a face mask if it is difficult not to keep a physical distance.
- Stay at home or leave the site immediately if you or someone in your bubble is sick or has any of the following symptoms:
cold, sneezing, sore throat, mild cough, fever (up to 38 ° C).Handen schudden is verboden.
- Always follow the directions of the campsite management and staff.
- If possible, pay by card, contactless or before arrival by bank transfer (at least 3 days before arrival due to payment processing).
- For guests from abroad, there is an obligation to fill in the public health passenger locator form 48 hours prior to arrival in Belgium <https://www.info-coronavirus.be/en/plf/>
- It is forbidden to receive visitors on the campsite, except by people who live under the same roof as the main tenant of the place or accommodation.
- In the sanitary facilities children under 9 must be accompanied by a member of their household.
- You are advised not to stay in the sanitary buildings longer than is strictly necessary.
- Outdoor playgrounds are accessible, for a maximum of 20 children under 12 years old.
